Horsham Township Referendum

Ballot Question

Shall the Horsham Township Charter be amended:

(1) to amend all mentions of "Councilman" to "Councilmember" and replace all gender-specific pronouns with gender-neutral pronouns throughout; (2) to provide that no Councilmember may serve on Council for more than two consecutive terms in office; (3) to amend the term "District Justice" to "Magisterial District Judge" to reflect the change in name to that position under state law; (4) to align the Township's advertisement requirements for proposed ordinances with applicable state law by providing that a general ordinance shall be advertised once no less than 7 days prior to the public hearing at which adoption thereof shall be considered, an ordinance relating to zoning or land development shall be advertised once a week for two consecutive weeks at least 7 days nor more than 30 days prior to such public hearing, and an ordinance relating to taxation shall be advertised at least once a week for three consecutive weeks not less than 7 days prior to such public hearing; (5) to provide that an ordinance may become effective immediately upon adoption by Council unless a later date is specified or required; (6) to repeal obsolete Section 402 so that the Township's taxing ability may be consistent with authority granted under the Home Rule Charter and Optional Plans Law and Local Tax Enabling Act; (7) to clarify that the voters may petition Council for the adoption or reconsideration of any ordinance except for those relating to the budget or capital program, appropriation of money, levy of taxes, salaries of Township officers or employees, or any zoning, land use, or subdivision or land development ordinance; and (8) to eliminate all Councilmember recall provisions which have been deemed unconstitutional.
